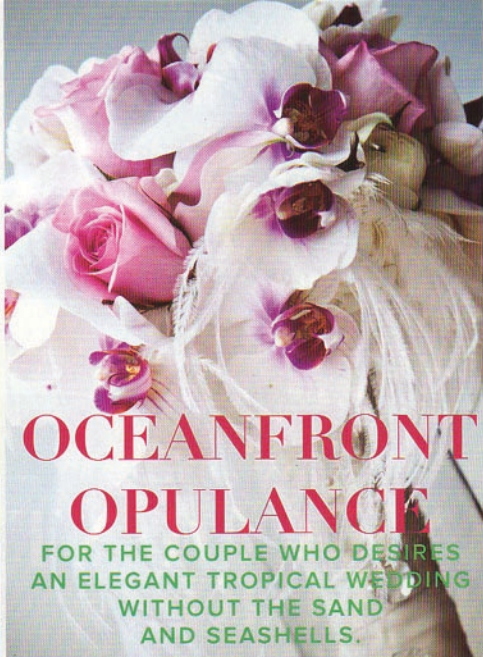


# WHAT'S YOUR DESTINATION WEDDING STYLE?

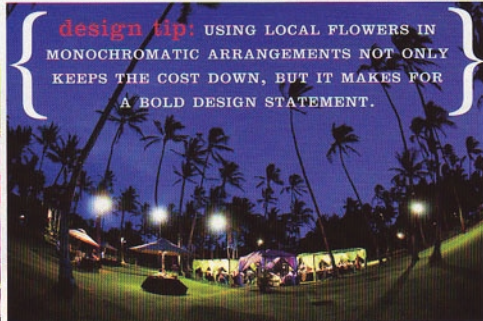
